



ABOUT US

ARISE (Association Representing International Student Exchange) sponsors highly qualified international students, ages 14-18, and places them in fully screened and selected American host families and high schools for a semester or academic year. Its founders have over 25 years of experience in the field of cultural exchange at the high school level.

Everyone involved in ARISE's program, from our main office to our international partners and local area representatives strive to create the experience of a lifetime for the student and the host family. Our host families are open and caring and treat the students, not simply as guests, but as true members of the family. Students are encouraged to participate in the family's daily activities and to involve themselves in extracurricular activities at their school. Our goal is to create lifelong relationships between the students and host families.

Standard F-1 Program

The Standard F-1 Program allows students to study in the U.S. at a lower cost than the select F-1 program. Students are placed in either a public or private high school for an academic year for one low price. Students are not allowed to choose the location or school; however, they have the following options:

- ◆ Students may choose a particular activity or interest that they would like to have available to them while participating in the program. (Activity must be pre-approved by ARISE.)
- ◆ ARISE **might** consider the option of allowing students to choose a location (region); however, it must be pre-approved by ARISE. Please contact us at info@arise-usa.org for more information.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAM?

- ◆ School tuition (All schools certified by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to issue the I-20 form are required by regulations to charge tuition.)
- ◆ Placement of the student in a fully screened, highly qualified host family.
- ◆ Room and board provided by the host family.
- ◆ Transportation of the student to/from the airport.
- ◆ Health insurance coverage
- ◆ Online orientation prior to the student's arrival in the U.S.
- ◆ Orientation conducted by the local area representative after the student's arrival in the U.S.
- ◆ Assistance and guidance from a local area representative, as well ARISE's staff throughout the student's participation in the program.



ASSISTANCE FROM ARISE:

ARISE is dedicated to providing unparalleled assistance to its students, host families and schools. Our local area representatives are thoroughly trained and are assigned with the task of maintaining monthly contact with the students and host families throughout the school year. They complete monthly evaluation reports and provide all parties with assistance and guidance when needed. All area representatives must reside within 120-miles of the host family's residence. ARISE's main office is also available to help whenever needed, and a full-time counselor is able to assist students and host families with the resolution of any problems.

Program Dates: Spring Semester (January 2021-June 2021); Fall Semester (August 2021-December 2021); Academic Year (August 2021-June 2022)

Non-refundable Application Fee: \$400 (Non-refundable)

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

To qualify, students must be:

- Between the ages of 14-18 years of age.
- Demonstrate maturity and the ability to live far from home for a period of an academic year.
- English requirements vary depending upon the school; however, students must possess sufficient proficiency in English to participate in an American classroom.
- Have the motivation and desire to fully immerse themselves in the American culture.



HOST FAMILIES

ARISE places its students in fully screened and highly qualified host families. Any family interested in hosting one of our students must complete an application, provide at least 3 personal references, and all members of the host family who are age 18 or older must undergo a criminal background check. An ARISE area representative will also meet with the family in their home prior to the student's arrival to assure that they are able to provide appropriate accommodations for the student. ARISE will also be provided with photos of the host family and their home. All host families are required to complete ARISE's online Host Family Orientation prior to the student's arrival in the U.S.
