Program Requirements:

The summer program is a great way for teens to experience life in the U.S. for a short time while living with an American host family and participating in their daily activities. To qualify, students must:

- Be between the ages of 14-18 years of age.
- Demonstrate maturity, independence and the ability to live far from home for a period of one month.
- Possess sufficient proficiency in English to communicate with the host family.
- Have the motivation and desire to fully immerse themselves in the American culture.

Students are required to complete an application and provide a personal video in which they describe their specific interests, hobbies and activities.
